Also receiving a Service Award was Korrect Plumbing for responding to the urgent need for plumbers in Dawson Springs, KY. They sent eight employees to serve for a week which enabled the building process to move forward, ensuring that homes were ready in a timely manner. Appreciation was expressed for the many ways BDM is supported including Children's Disaster Services, Church World Service kit assemblies, fundraising, donations, and prayer. Together we rejoice in the ministry accomplished in 2023 and look ahead to 2024.
