**CDS Workers Serve** – Children's Disaster Services (CDS) has recently had two deployments. Two S. Ohio/KY workers went to Marble Hill, MO, the site of an EF2 tornado on April 5. Another team of CDS workers, including one volunteer from our district, worked in the Little Rock, Arkansas area. Here a series of three tornadoes hit the area on March 31. Both teams set up childcare centers in a MARC (Multi-Agency Resource Center). They cared for children, providing a safe and comforting place where children can play and receive emotional support while their parents/guardians are working with the available agencies to obtain needed assistance.
